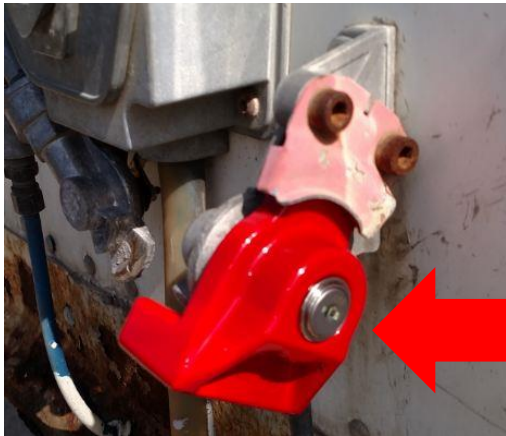


What is a glad hand lock:



Emergency Air line lock,
commonly referred to as a
“glad hand lock”

To Lock a trailer:

First identify the Emergency brake airline on the front of the trailer:



The emergency brake airline will be
marked with a red metal shroud.

Next step is to place the glad hand lock against the airline hook-up, ensuring the open side slides over the protruding receptacle, and then slide the glad hand lock under the metal shroud.



Once in place, press the lock cylinder gently until it depresses and clicks into place. At this point the glad hand lock is secured onto the trailer and a truck cannot connect to the system.



To unlock the trailer:

Insert the key into the lock cylinder and turn until the lock cylinder pops out of the glad hand lock.



Then remove the glad hand by sliding it from under the metal shroud.

Essentials of Trailer Safety and Physical Security

Any trailer with product, people, or equipment must have a glad hand lock on it.

No one may be inside of a trailer that does not have a glad hand lock on it; or wheel chocked/dock locked

Before unlocking a trailer, it should be verified that the trailer is empty of people and equipment.

Only trained personnel may put on or remove a Glad Hand lock from a trailer.
